



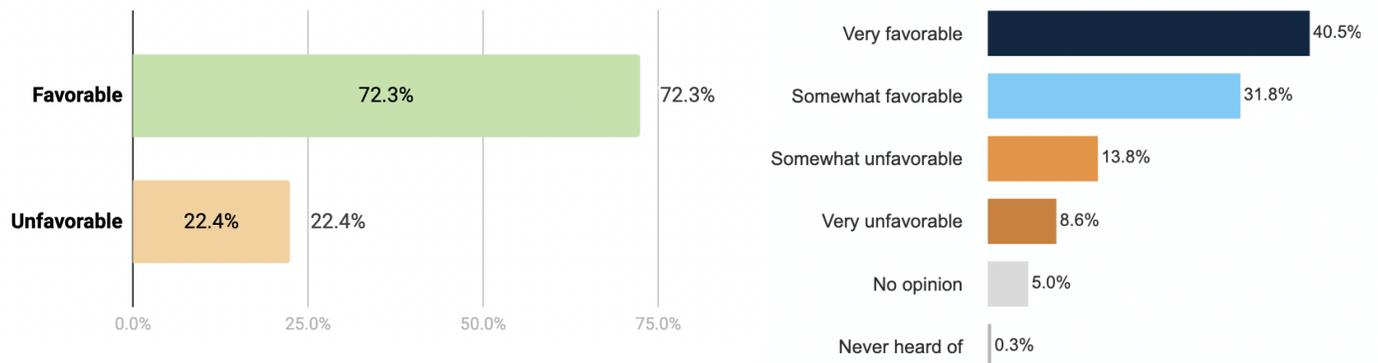
## TEXAS STATEWIDE – PUBLIC SURVEY MEMORANDUM

**RE:** Survey of Likely General Election Voters

**METHODOLOGY:** This probabilistic survey was conducted by [Cygнал](#) March 22 – 24, 2021, with 600 likely general election voters. It has a margin of error of ±4.0%. Interviews were conducted using Interactive Voice Response (IVR) to landline phones, and voters received invitations to participate in the survey via SMS and email with a secure link tied to their voter record. This survey was weighted to a likely general election universe.

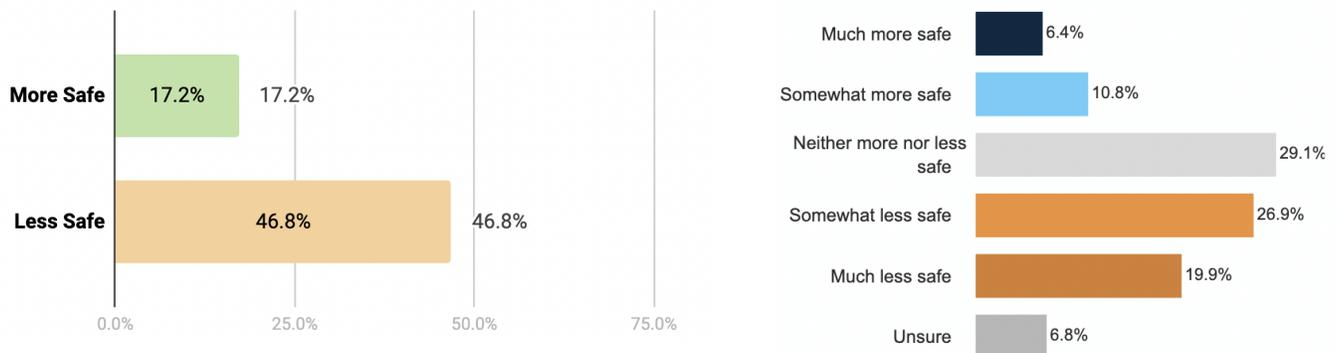
### Texas voters have a favorable opinion of local law enforcement.

1. Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of your local law enforcement?



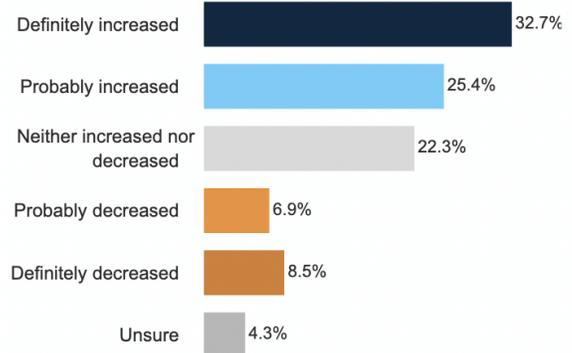
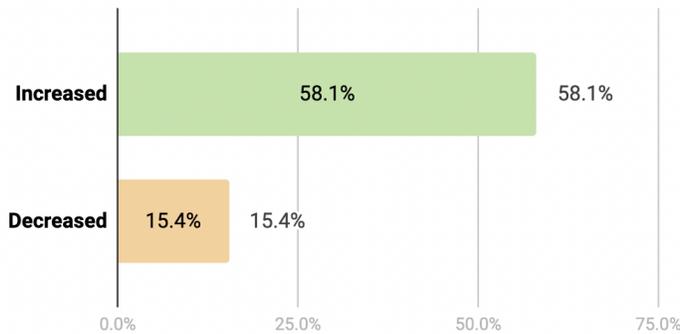
### Nearly half of respondents think the state is less safe than it was 5-10 years ago.

2. In your opinion, is Texas more or less safe today than it was 5-10 years ago?



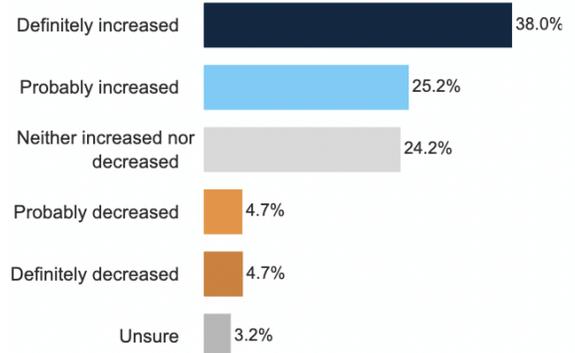
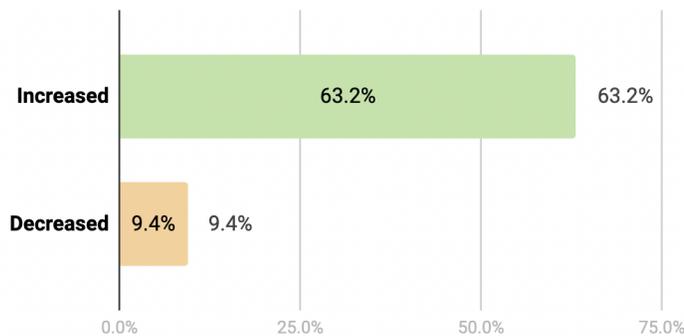
### More than half of voters want their local police force's budget to be increased.

3. In your opinion, should the budget for your local police force be increased or decrease



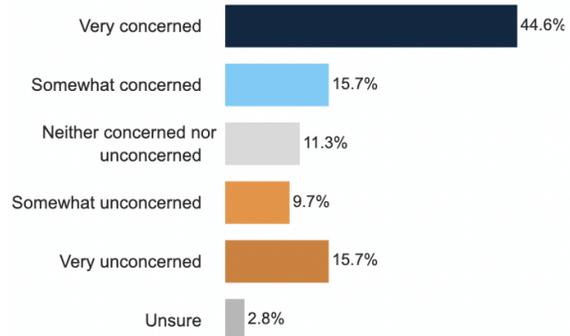
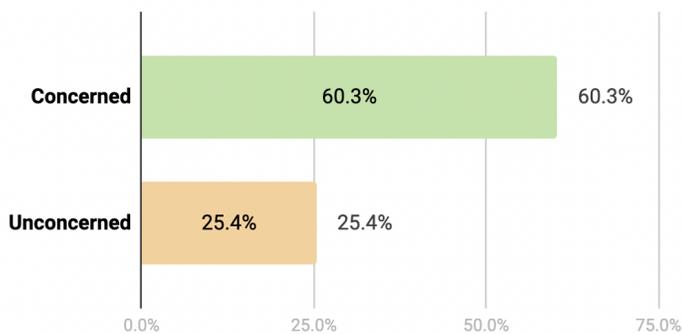
### Nearly two-thirds of Texas voters want more police officers on the street.
